Styles and influences range from The Allman Brothers and Lynyrd Skynyrd to Stevie Ray Vaughan, Tom Petty, The Rolling Stones and John Mayer.

Band members are Brian Futch- Lead Vox, Lead Guitar; Todd Bennett- Lead Vox, Rhythm Guitar; Phil Miller- Background Vox, Bass, Harmonica; and Rylie Bishop- Drums.

While already having been through their mid life crisis, they are now free to rock your world. The formation of Red Velvet Mojo is an interesting story. Rylie and Brian were both members of an internet musicians community, though at the time, Brian lived in Mississippi. Brian then asked his cousin, Todd, who lived just north of Atlanta in Buford, to join the jam. After completing the lineup with friend Phil, Red Velvet Mojo was born.
